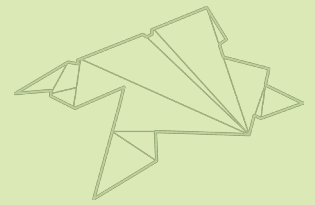

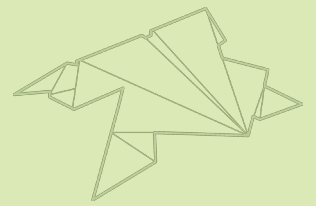

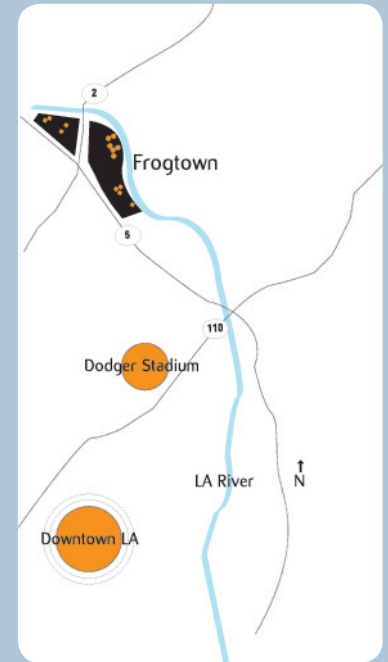
## WHERE IS FROGTOWN?

*Frogtown is located where the 2 & 5 FWY intersect.*

*The Artwalk stretches from Fletcher Drive to the Taylor Yard Pedestrian Bridge to the south.*

*We strive to be a car-free, low-impact event. Please park on Riverside Drive or take one of the alternate transportation options.*

## VISITING VENUES FAQ

### "How do I get to all the different venues?"

*Well, make sure you wear your walking shoes! Most venues can be accessed via the shared LA River Bicycle / Pedestrian Path. The entire route is about 1.5 miles.*

### "Can I ride my bike to the venues?"

*Yes! We also encourage low-impact options such as bikes, scooters, skateboards, etc. along the river path.*

### "My grandma doesn't like walking. Is there an option for her?"

*You're in luck. We will have **FREE** pedicabs available to ferry people along the river path from Fletcher to the new Taylor Yard Bridge and back.*
